What is PRINCE2®?

PRINCE2® is a process-based approach for project management providing an easily tailored and scalable method for the management of all types of projects. The method is the de-facto standard for project management in the UK and is practiced worldwide by many leading private and public sector organisations.

Course Introduction

This five-day accredited course introduces participants to the PRINCE2® approach to project management and allows them to achieve the recognised PRINCE2® foundation and practitioner qualification.

The course examines the principles upon which the methodology is based, the processes that describe a step-wise progression through the project lifecycle and the themes that describe aspects of project management that must be addressed continually. It also helps to understand the way in which the methodology can be tailored to suit different situations.

The course will include the PRINCE2® foundation and practitioner exams.

The course will use a mix of lecture, group work and self-study to reflect different learning styles.

Individuals who are experienced project managers or those who like to pursue project management within their careers and who wish to gain knowledge of the PRINCE2® project management methodology and achieve an internationally recognised project management qualification

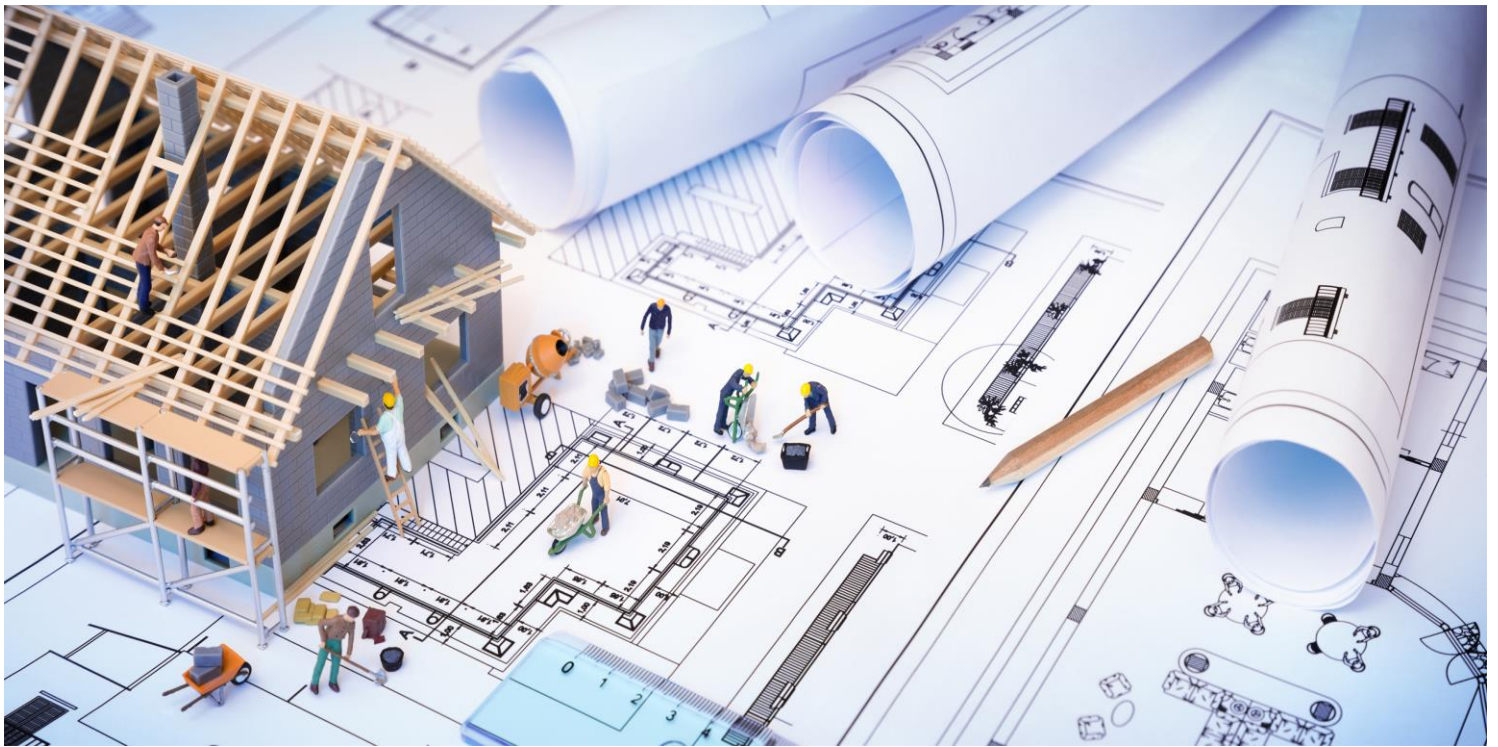

Course Study

Participants will be provided with their own copy of the PRINCE2® 2017 manual four weeks before the start of the course. There will be a programme of pre-course self study (approx 12 – 15 hours) using the manual and participants will be sent a study framework to assist them. During the course participants will be required to carry out approximately 2 hours of evening study.

The PRINCE2® Foundation exam

The Foundation exam comprises 60 multiple choice questions taken from the detail of the PRINCE2® method. This one-hour exam is 'closed-book' with a pass-mark of 55%. Delegates must pass the PRINCE2® foundation exam before undertaking the practitioner level exam.

The PRINCE2® Practitioner exam

The Practitioner exam is in an Objective Testing Exam format whereby students will apply the PRINCE2® methodology to a project scenario. This is a 2.5 hr exam with 68 marks available and the pass mark is 55%. This is an open book exam.
