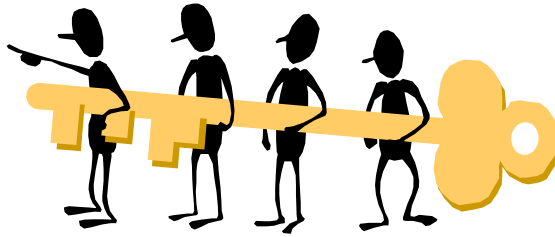


Project Team Leadership Skills
